

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAJORD NO. 128

BYLAW NO. 175

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128 to designate the property known as the Kronau Cemetary Site at NW 22-15-17-W2, - Saskatchewan as being a site of historical value.

WHEREAS Part III of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Kronau Cemetary Site at NW 22-15-17-W2 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk-of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128 enacts as follows:

1. There-is designated as being of historical value and interest the real property known as the Kronau Cemetary Site at NW 22-15-17-W2 and legally described as:

Firstly: that portion of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty-Two (22) in Township Fifteen (15) in Range Seventeen (17) West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing four hundred and one one-thousandths (0.401) of an acre more or- less, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the southern boundary of said quarter section four hundred and eighty-six (486) -feet Easterly, from the south West corner of said quarter section thence Northerly and parallel to the Western boundary of said quarter section, seventy-five (75) feet, thence Easterly and parallel to the said Southern boundary, two hundred and thirty-three (233) feet, thence Southerly and parallel to the said Western boundary to the said Southern boundary, thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary to the point of commencement and

Secondly: that portion of the South West Quarter of the said Section Twenty-Two (22), containing seventy-one-hundredths (0.70) of an acre more-or less, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the Western boundary of said quarter section, eighty-five (85) feet southerly from the North West corner of said quarter section; thence Easterly and parallel to the Northern boundary of said quarter section Seven Hundred and Nineteen (719) feet, thence Northerly and parallel to the said Western boundary to the said Northern boundary, thence Westerly along the said Northern boundary to a point four hundred and eighty-six (486) feet westerly from the said Western boundary, thence Southerly and parallel to the said Western boundary sixty-three (63) feet; thence Westerly and parallel to said Northern boundary to the said Western boundary and thence Southerly along the said Western boundary to the point of commencement.

The significance of the site is as follows:

- a) The site was established in 1895.
  - b) Many early pioneers of the Kronau area are buried on the proposed heritage site.
  - c) Much history of the area is in danger of total obliteration should a full restoration project not be implemented.
  - d) Restored and beautified the Kronau Cemetery could serve as an object for community pride.
2. The rural municipal administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
  3. The-rural municipal administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
  4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
