BYLAW NO. 266

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to sections 2 and 3 hereof, no person shall discharge a firearm, air gun or spring gun within the boundaries of the Hamlet of Kronau.
2. This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm, air gun or spring gun is discharged outside of the Hamlet of Kronau:
 - (a) by any person on land with the consent of the occupant of such land;
 - (b) by any person permitted to hunt under the Migratory Birds Convention Act (Canada), as amended from time to time, or the regulations thereunder; or
 - (c) during the open season where the person is the holder of a license to hunt big game or game birds issued to him under *The Wildlife Act, 1998*.
3. The administrator of the municipality is hereby authorized to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit in writing entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty by-law of this municipality.
