

BYLAW NO. 78

A DEFERRED WIDENING BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF A BUILDING LINE ALONG THE MAIN MARKET GRID ROAD.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128 of Saskatchewan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The roads shown on the plan attached to and forming part of this bylaw are hereby declared to have been widened from sixty-six (66) feet to one hundred (100) feet in compliance with the standards established for Main Market Grid Roads.
2. In furtherance of the Main Market Grid Road scheme, a building line is hereby established along the said roads which shall be one hundred and fifty (150) feet in perpendicular depth throughout from the centre line of the road allowance.
3. Upon submission of this bylaw to the Register of Land Titles for the Regina Land Registration District it shall be unlawful for any person to:
 - a) erect or alter any building or structure;
 - b) plant trees or shelter belt;
 - c) construct a dug-out;
 - d) place any granary, machinery or other obstruction;

between the building line and the edge of the road allowance

Read three times and finally PASSED in Council assemblies by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128, at Lajord in the Province of Saskatchewan, this fifth day of March, A.D. 1958.
