A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No 293 known as the Zoning Bylaw

Bylaw No. 305

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lajord No. 128 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 293 as follows:

1. Section Part 1 - Interpretation is amended by adding subsection (6) Definitions the following new definitions in the correspondent alphabetical order;

**Storage Facility** - a unit or units for the storage of personal goods, materials and equipment, household goods, furniture, general merchandise, vehicles or hazardous materials.

**Warehousing** - establishments primarily engaged in the indoor and/or outdoor storage of a general line of goods.

2. Section Part 4 - Agricultural District (A) subsection (3)(b) is amended by adding immediately after "Vacation Farms..." the following;

Storage Facilities and Warehousing.

3. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by the Minister of Government Relations.


