1. Call to Order: 6:34pm

6. Old Business:

a. Yard Waste Bin

- i. Has been taken away for the season. Will return again in the fall.
- ii. Can we keep it all summer? We have not kept it in the past, but we can look at it and the feasibility.
- **iii.** The problem is the bin costs us \$28,000 a year because we get charged due to people disposing of items that are not yard waste.
- iv. We will look at the budget to see if this is something we can look into.

b. Gopher /Vole Control

- i. Chad has treated once already this year for Gophers.
- ii. Chad has put bait stations for voles but have not been successful.
- **iii.** Chad will redo the area behind the dug-out, by the ball diamond, or anywhere he sees a fresh hole.

c. Weed Spraying

 i. Chad has been spraying when he can (low wind and no rain). Has a good kill on the green spaces.



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ii. Chad is looking to hit some of the gravel spaces with round-up.

d. Speed Bumps

- i. Have been laid. There is more to go out.
- **ii.** We will add in front of the day care on Matthew and in front of the post office.
- **iii.** The bumps help encourage people to stop in front of the stop signs.
- **iv.** Corner of Koochin and Railway can be an issue. Chad will look at putting some on, but he grades those often.

e. Town Shop Update

- i. Hooking up town water? SEL inquired The plan was to pull water out of the dugout just like KADER. If we are interested in town water, SEL said they would waive the hook-up fee. This is something we can look into.
 - We are looking to pull in a line from the dugout and run it to the shop. The line should have a float to help.
- **ii.** Prep has been done and piles have been poured. Foundation should be poured soon.

f. Parking in Easements

- i. Reminder that easements are not for parking equipment.
- ii. We are working with the RM to see if there are permits that could be created. We are trying to come up with a plan so everyone knows what they can and cannot do.
- **iii.** Currently the rule is not parking on open lots and no parking on easements.
- iv. This is a problem in many hamlets, not just in Kronau.



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7. New Business:

a. Lift Station PM and Alarm Notification

- i. June 27, there was a storm that caused the power to go out. This caused the entire lift-station to go down. As a result, this caused some people to have their sewer back-up into their house.
- **ii.** This has caused vulnerability to the system. We would need to upgrade the system to include a dial-out to alert us when the system is not working properly.
- **iii.** We have a company (Municipal) that comes out and maintains the lift station. Moving forward, we will also add more regular checks and protocols.
- **iv.** In the event that the power goes out, we will ensure the lift-station is checked once the power is restored.
- v. We will also work at collecting email addresses and remind people to join the RM notification program (H2 Notification)

b. Sewer Line Cleaning

i. July 31 we will have Roto Rooter come out to flush out the sewer lines.

c. Blading Streets

- i. Roads were graveled by the RM.
- **ii.** Chad will continue to grade the streets and look into fixing some of the washboards around town.
- **iii.** Chad is chatting with Sedley and share ideas.

d. Tree Trimming

- **i.** Chad has trimmed some streets down main street by the park.
- ii. Chad will be looking at taking down some of the dead



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branches/trees.

8. Community Connections:

a. Museum

- **i.** Kids Camps Aug. 11-15
- ii. New Exhibit this summer Back to the Future (Kronau past, present & future)

b. Kronau Curling Rink

 i. Campers parking for special events – remind them not to park on the grass when it is wet.

9. Open Floor:

- **a. Lagoon** Who can use it? Is it just to anyone from Kronau or the RM can use it? Terry has seen 4 different trucks going in. If they are coming from outside of Kronau, they have to pay us a fee.
 - Terry observed there was no lock and the gate was partially open.
