Kronau Curling Rink

1. **Call to Order:** 6:30pm
 2. **Attendance:** 9 community members present
 3. **Conflict of Interest:** none
 4. **Adoption of agenda:** ~carried
 5. **Minutes distributed and adoption of minutes:** ~carried
 6. **Old Business:**
 - a. **Queen City Septic Lagoon Access** – because of their previous history at the lagoon (dumping manure) we took away their access. They are wanting to gain access again. We have approved them but will be monitoring them closely.
 - i. **Countryside Septic** – Ivan booked him for July, and he is offering to give a break if we get a large number of people who group together. ~\$100 a house. A sign-up will be put up at the post office in June. More information will be shared on Facebook.
 - b. **Culvert Opening** – We will bring the backhoe in from the RM to open the ends of the culverts. We will monitor the thaw and proceed when necessary.
 - c. **Skating Rink Gate** – Chad welded a new bin and fixed the gate as someone had twisted and it was near falling off.
 - d. **Alleys** – Question pertaining opening alleys as some are quite high.
 - i. Since the ground is not frozen, the thaw should allow for it to soak in.
 - ii. Chad will take a look to see if clearing anything is feasible.

- iii. Chad did attempt to go down one alley, but it was not possible to attempt the others.
- iv. Next year, Chad will try to blow out the alleys and easements as much as possible to help with the thaw.

7. New Business:

a. Spring Thaw & Drainage

- i. We experienced a very fast thaw this spring, which caused some flooding issues – snow melted, but many culverts were still frozen solid.
- ii. **Motion:** To approve hiring Hydrovac to clean out blocked culverts to assist with drainage. ~carried.

b. Leippi Bay Road Conditions

- i. The road is a muddy mess resulting in cars getting stuck.
- ii. This is due to a shut-off valve being installed by SEL in the fall and the road was not repaired sufficiently.
- iii. Chad contacted Gerld about it. We will continue to work with SEL to ensure this is fixed properly to ensure future road issues do not happen.

c. Town Shop Update

i. Plans Approved

- Payment for the plans is taken from an insurance claim from wind damage to the current shop last year.
- We are able to now send it out for tender. We will continue to update at our meetings as things progress.
