

 - Thank you to everyone who participated. It is great to see such great community spirit!
 - b. **Status on Town Shop:**
 - No new updates since our last meeting
 - c. **Town Hall Plans/Ideas:**
 - The hall has now been moved into the ownership of the Hamlet.
 - At this point we are investigating options for the building.
 - We had an engineer report conducted in April 2024 – this can be made available to residents.
 - We have been paying for the hall's utilities, and the expenses show that each residence has been paying approximately \$150 a year from their taxes toward this.
 - If we update the building and bring it back to code, the cost could be approximately \$2500-\$3000 per residence. This is not something we are willing to do.



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- Question was asked if it is necessary or worthwhile. Is there a need and will it be utilized?
- We have not had anyone come forward to volunteer to create an advisory board to run it. We have also not had anyone show interest in renting the space – people want to use it for free, but that service is not feasible with the costs to bring it back to a useable state.
- We could query if we could lease the building to another organization/business.
- Tearing down the building will likely cost \$50-60,000 – because the building was kind of thrown on the hamlet, the RM has offered to cover the cost of the demolition.
- We will continue to discuss this in upcoming meetings to try to give the community time to voice their opinions.
- We will investigate a poll system to send out to residents to get their opinions.


